

Memorandum of Understanding between
COOMET, the Euro-Asian Cooperation of National Metrological Institutions,
and NCSL International

This Memorandum of Understanding is made on 25 July, 2016 between COOMET and NCSL International. Review of this Memorandum shall be made on or before 25 July, 2019, at which time this Agreement may be extended or terminated.

This Memorandum of Understanding is designed to reflect the understandings between COOMET, the Euro-Asian Cooperation of National Metrological Institutions and NCSL International, a public nonprofit organization Serving the World of Measurement.

COOMET and NCSL International have the common overall objective of providing an exchange of information with position papers and technical articles serving the measurement community. A major goal for the coming years is an opportunity to collaborate on the development of technical documents that are mutually beneficial to the organizations, their memberships and the metrology community at large. The two organizations should be a unifying voice for the metrology community regarding educational and technical issues that have a direct impact on measurement activities worldwide. This will be accomplished by:

- *Meeting annually to discuss mutual benefits, creating strategies and action plans,*
- *Presenting activities and progress on projects at each organization's GA/Board Meeting*
- *Participating on technical and standards writing committees within each organization*

Meetings shall be held to review the implementation of this agreement each year during the NCSL International Board of Directors.

COOMET and NCSL International hereby express agreement to all of the above and enter into a joint agreement until such time that either agency shall amend or revise said agreement in writing.
