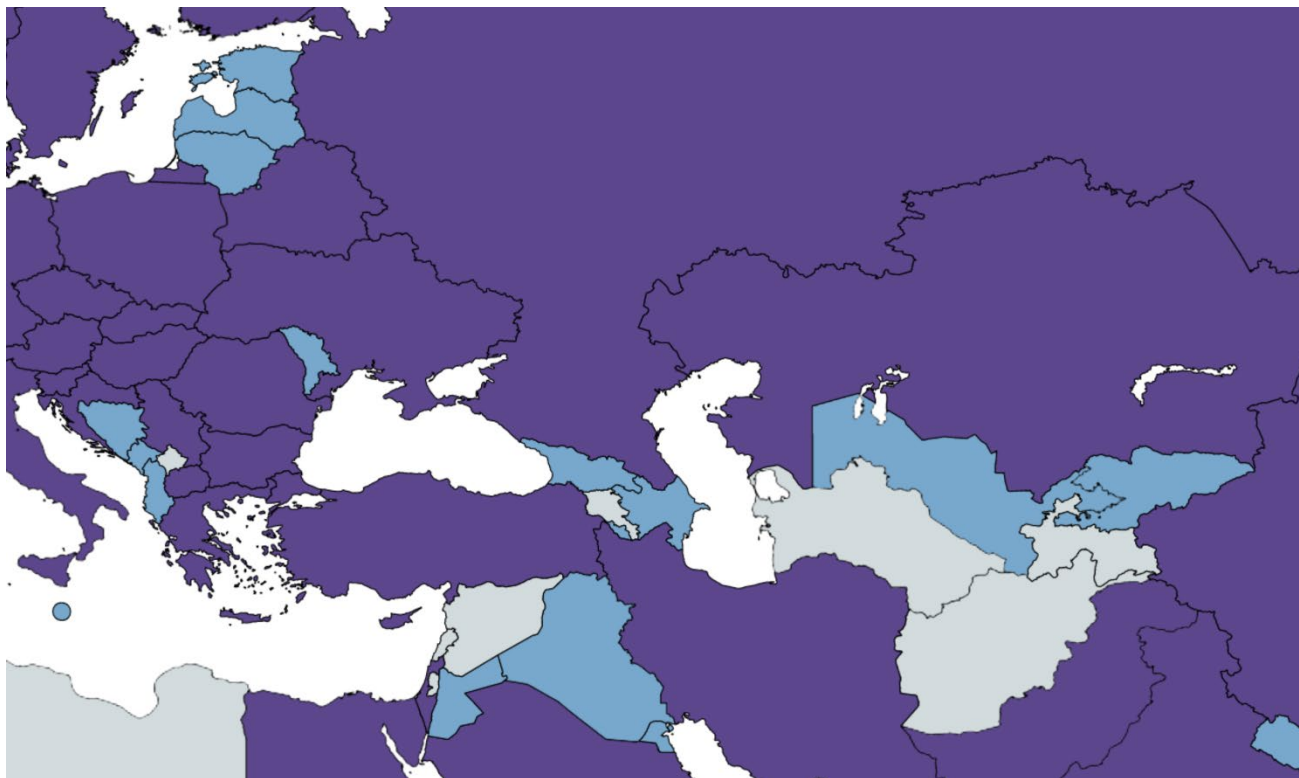
Update on OIML activities

Membership categories and fees

- Four classes according to population:
 - Class 1: ≤ 10 million
 - Class 2: > 10 million to ≤ 40 million
 - Class 3: > 40 million to ≤ 100 million
 - Class 4: > 100 million
- Class reductions possible according to GNI/ capita
- Always used for Member States
- Used for Corresponding Members from 2023
- Fees reduced in 2012 and unchanged 2013-2021
- In new budget, fees will increase by 1.4 %/ year over the period 2022–2025

- Possibilities for Corresponding Member participation in OIML work have significantly increased since 1955
- Previous situation:
 - Fixed annual fee, regardless of population and participation
 - 10 % of Class 1 Member State fee (€1 420 in 2022)
- From 2023, fees are based on the four classes
- Over the period 2024–2028, fees will increase progressively to become 50 % of equivalent Member State fee by 2028



Participation in OIML technical work

- Increase in new or proposed activities in new “non-traditional” areas of legal metrology:
 - Blood pressure instruments
 - Medical thermometers
 - Electric vehicle chargers
 - ...

57th CIML Meeting October 2022

- Publications approved:
 - Updated VIML
 - Two revised Basic publications: B 12, B 19
 - One reconfirmed Recommendation: R 139
 - Three new, revised or updated Documents:
D 5, D 10, D 37
- Four new technical work projects approved



58th CIML Meeting October 2023

- 17-19 October 2023
- Will be held in-person only in Chiang Mai, Thailand
- Website and online registration will be launched soon
- Working Document and documents for approval will be available mid-July



Electric Vehicle Charging Systems

- New project on *Electric vehicle charging stations* approved October 2022 because of urgent need identified by Member States for harmonised regulation in this area
- New OIML Guide (G 22) approved September 2022
- Project Group continuing to develop a full OIML Recommendation
- Next meeting (hybrid) 5 June 2023 in Delft, Netherlands



OIML Training Event – Prepackaged goods

- Pilot event to be held at the German Metrology Academy (DAM), Bad Reichenhall, Germany in July 2023
- Maximum 25 participants
- Intended as pilot event with intention to hold more
- OIML Training Events are free of charge
- Travel, accommodation and per diem at participants' cost or through funding agencies

- Revision of D 1 published in 2020 with new title:
National metrology systems – Developing the institutional and legislative framework
- OIML and BIPM jointly developing e -learning package on D 1 aimed at decision makers
- Promotional brochure and inserts now available summarising D 1
